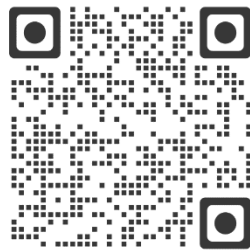

ENROLLMENT IN THE LIBRARY

Library services may be used by students, employees, and external associates of the Faculty, students and employees of other constituents and organizational units of the University of Rijeka, as well as other citizens.

a) Library registration for users with an AAI identity: It is necessary to provide consent for the use of personal data via the link:

b) Library registration for users without an AAI identity: Via the registration form which can be downloaded here. The completed and signed registration form must be submitted at the Library desk or sent to the e-mail address

knjiznica@ffri.uniri.hr.

Registration is considered complete upon visiting the Library, presenting an identity card, and picking up the membership card, after which you can start using the services.

CATALOG SEARCH

The Primo VE Discovery service is the online catalog of the FFRI Library, which enables unified access to physical, electronic, and digital library materials. Through the search engine, you can access library collections, scientific journals, open-access academic sources, and databases under national subscription. The catalog allows you to search the entire Library collection, check the availability of materials for borrowing, and, through advanced search options and interactive queries to the AI assistant, find relevant sources beyond the Library's holdings.



LOAN

Each user of the Library can borrow 5 books for a loan period of 30 days.

LIBRARY COLLECTION

The library collection is interdisciplinary, predominantly social and humanistic in content, adapted to the needs of studies and scientific work at the Faculty. Content of the fund: monographs, magazines, master's and doctoral theses, electronic material.

ACCESS TO THE FUND IS FREE

under condition that you leave your personal belongings in the lockers for which you receive a key. If you want the librarian to bring you materials, you need to fill out a promissory note.

PROMISSORY NOTE

– a piece of paper that is located next to the computers, and which is filled in according to the specified items (author of the work, title, signature, your first and last name). One of the items is SIGNATURE.

LOAN RULES

Borrowed books have a sticker on the back and are marked with tags

"OTVORENI" and "ČITAONICA".

Books marked "OTVORENI" can be borrowed for a period of 30 days.

The late fee for an "otvoreni" copy is 0,15 EUR per book / day.

Books marked "ČITAONICA" can be borrowed for ONE day, over weekends, holidays and non-working days.

The late fee for the "čitaonica" copy is 0,70 EUR per book / day.

Journals, dissertations and reference collection are used in the Library.
