Between Istanbul and al-Andalus: Vera Stein Erlich's conception of the 'Oriental cultural style'

Croatian anthropologist Vera Stein Erlich (1897-1980) is best known for her research on the transformation of Yugoslav family (Family in Transition: A Study of 300 Yugoslav Villages), while her interest in cultural hybridity, imperial legacies, and regional cultural styles has remained for the most part overlooked. The lecture will take a look at her conception of Oriental cultural style (one of four cultural styles to be found in Yugoslavia according to her analysis).



Bojan Baskar is Professor of Social Anthropology and the Mediterranean Studies at the Ethnology and Cultural Anthropology Department of the University of Ljubljana.

His current research interests include the Mediterranean anthropology, empires and imperial legacies, anthropology of food, and history of anthropology. His most recent research has focused on the work of Croatian anthropologist Vera Stein Erlich.
